

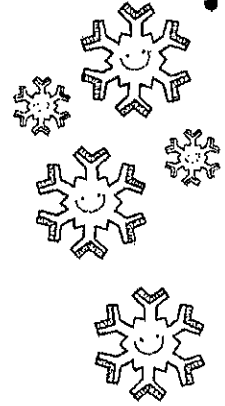

Here is Pip the penguin. She likes to go fishing at the pond. Pip will try to catch a fish.

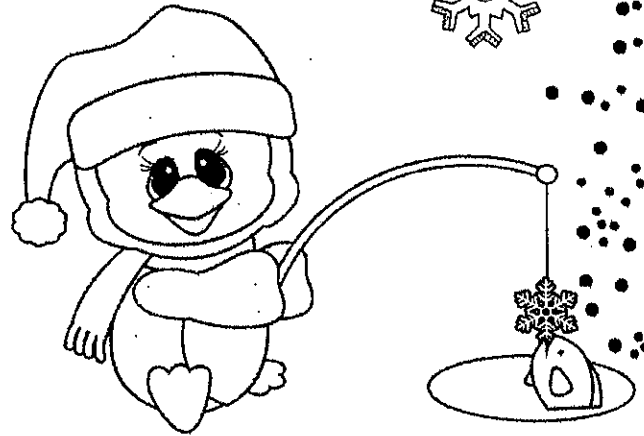
